 - Matthew 19:26
 - Malachi 3:10
 - Isaiah 60:21-22

- Elisha was not afraid to jump right in and serve the Shunammite woman and help the child in need. Read these verses on this topic and write down your thoughts
 - Colossians 1:28-29
 - Galatians 5:13 and 1 Peter 2:16-17
 - Romans 12:9-13
 - Luke 17:10
- God rewarded the Shunammite woman for her generosity to Elisha. Read the following verses on being generous and make observations about each one.
 - 2 Corinthians 9:6-8
 - 1 Timothy 6:17-19
 - Proverbs 11:24-25
- Elisha relied on God and then acted in faith. Read these stories about others who did the same and jot down your thoughts.
 - 1 Kings 18:36-39; Elijah's prayer. Also read the context verses 20 through 40.
 - 2 Kings 19:14-19; Hezekiah's prayer. Also read context 2 Kings 18:17-19:36
