An Inventory of Spiritual Gifts

The following exercise is designed to help you consider spiritual gifts with which you may be endowed The survey is not without limitations and imperfections, yet it should point you in a direction that will prove beneficial. You should work your way through the list of statements marking to what extent each statement is true in your life--always, often, seldom, or never. Your response will be given a value as indicated by the numbers just above the dark line on each page. At the end of the exercise, instructions will be given as to how to process your responses.
